Corinth was a hub for sexual sin & promiscuity... The church wanted to know how to live as Christians in the midst of the culture they were immersed in!

We too live in a sex-crazed culture, where there is rampant sexual temptation, deception, distortion, & abuse! We, like the Corinthians, need <u>practical wisdom</u> in order to honor God with our bodies, our sexuality, & our relationships!

Sex is not a <u>bad thing</u>! It's a gift of God, in the proper context of marriage, for the purpose of procreation, partnership, pleasure, & purity!

- Procreation in marriage "Be fruitful and multiply... Fill the earth..."
- Partnership in marriage "It is not good for man to be alone..." A suitable helper/companion was needed. "The two shall become one flesh..."
- Pleasure in marriage An entire book of the Bible is devoted to the intimacy & pleasure of sexuality within marriage Song of Songs!
- Purity in marriage Vs. 9 "But if they cannot exercise self-control, they should marry. For it is better to marry than to burn with passion."

"I want you to be free from <u>anxieties</u>. The unmarried man is anxious about the things of the Lord, how to please the Lord. But the married man is anxious about worldly things, how to please his wife, & his interests are divided..."

What if we began to see "singleness" as a gift & opportunity, not a burden?

Vs. 35 – <mark>"I say this for your benefit, not to lay any restraint upon you, but to promote good order & to secure your undivided devotion to the Lord." "</mark>

But what if you are "unequally yoked" in marriage (have an unbelieving spouse)?
