Heidelberg Catechism

Question 94. What does the Lord require in the first commandment?

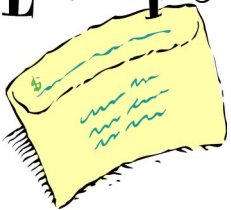

CHURCH COMMUNICATION UPDATES!

We send out a lot of our communications through BREEZE, our database management software. They have notified us of some updates that we need to make you aware of:

***If you have been receiving text messages from us through BREEZE, this month you will receive a message asking you to verify that you want to receive our text messages. You do need to reply YES to OPT-IN or you will no longer receive our text messages.**

***Also, GMAIL occasionally does security updates. They have done one recently that may have sent BREEZE emails to your SPAM folder. If you have a GMAIL account, please make sure you check your spam and mark these emails as NOT SPAM. Then you should start receiving the BREEZE emails in your INBOX again.**
