Hello BRC family! We strive to be a congregation that is not only welcoming to kids, and young families, but a church that celebrates their presence with us. With that being said, we want to make sure that what we do, and how we do it, conveys this! Starting with Sunday worship... Children are welcome to stay in the service with us and worship beside us, at both services!

We make kid's resources available at our welcome table, including a sermon page for kids. We have reserved seating at the back tables for families with young kids so that they can have a more user friendly space available to them. There is a cry room, and the fellowship area, with a tv showing the live stream of the service, so that if/when stepping out of the service temporarily is necessary, families can still stay engaged. At the second service a nursery is available, and Sunday school is offered for kids Pre-K - 5th grade. Kids are invited to experience worship with their friends in this capacity as well, after the opening set of music.

We want kids, and their families to feel at home here, and to know that this church puts a high emphasis on young people (just as Jesus did).
