- Don't just send Christmas cards to your family & friends, send them to those who most people would not choose to send one to!
- Don't just check off all the names on your shopping list, make a list of all the names of Jesus & check off all the ways He is God's gift to us!
- Don't just listen to Christmas music all month, go and sing some of those songs at a nursing home!
- Don't just put a nativity scene up in your house, give the nativity scene to someone else, one piece at a time!
- Don't just get your family picture with Santa, get your family in the picture of what God is doing in your community!
- Don't just participate in gift exchanges, give gifts to others without expectation of anything in return!
- Don't just write a letter to Santa, write a letter to Jesus (a prayer) lifting up the wants/needs of others!
- Don't just do the same old things, start a new faith tradition this Christmas!
