How is giving the gift of love going? What about the gift of sharing your faith? These aren't one-time gifts... So, let's keep giving... for God will keep <u>supplying!</u>

Back in 1 Corinthians 13, there is still one more gift in the big 3 of abiding/ enduring/lasting gifts... Faith, <u>Hope</u>, & Love!

What's interesting about this gift is that you can't have the other 2 without this one! "Love" & "Faith" both include "Hope" in their Biblical definitions!

- *"Love hopes all things!"* Love is built upon the foundation of hope!

 "Faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen!" Hope is what gives faith <u>substance!</u> There's no faith w/out hope!

When hope is lost, everything that is life-giving is gone! But when hope abides, no matter what our circumstances, we can persevere!

- We can get thru the dead of winter, because there is hope of spring...
- We can get thru <u>suffering</u>, b/c there is hope of deliverance & purpose...
- We can get thru the loss of a loved one, b/c there is hope of heaven...
- We can get thru infertility, b/c there is hope of future pregnancy...
- We can get thru finals week, b/c there's hope of winter break/graduation...
- We can get thru financial hardships, b/c there's hope of generosity/blessings...
- We can get thru a bad diagnosis, b/c there is hope of healing/treatment...
- We can get thru separation, b/c there's hope of reconciliation/reuniting...
- We can get thru <u>sorrow</u>, b/c there is hope of joy & happiness restored...
- We can get thru loneliness, b/c there's hope in the presence of others/love...

Hope is the engine, the fuel, the lifeline, the <u>security blanket</u> that gets us thru life! It does not originate in us, but in the power of God! **2 Corinthians 4:7-9**

1 Peter 1:3-7 -Our lasting hope is found in the person & work of Jesus Christ! Hope has a name... <u>Immanuel</u>... God with us... Jesus!

He is our hope in... winter... suffering... loss... infertility... finals week... financial hardships... bad diagnosis... separation... sorrow... loneliness... etc.

Hope is not a one-time gift. For as Jesus <u>lives</u>... so too does hope! Since Jesus is eternal, hope is a gift that will always keep on giving!

We have been talking about giving gifts this year that are more experiential, rather than just more stuff under the tree! These kinds of gifts give

something to look forward to! They are gifts that keep giving... Examples:

What does the gift of Jesus in the manger really do for us? It gives us <u>hope!</u> Hope that transcends Christmas... Hope that is on-going, life-giving... a gift of...

H – <u>Heavenly perspective</u> – Seeing life through God's lens, rather than ours!
