In the past 3,500 years, the world has seen less than 300 years of peace.

In the last 5 ½ millennia, more than 8,000 peace treaties have been broken, & more than 14,000 wars have been fought with a total of 4 billion casualties.

As amazing as this story is, of an unlikely Christmas truce, the war continued! How can you sing Christmas carols, read the Christmas story, exchange gifts on Christmas day together & then go back to shooting each other the day after?

"In despair I bowed my head... 'There is no peace on earth,' I said, for hate is strong & mocks the song of peace on earth, goodwill to men!"

Where is the "good news of great joy for all people" that Christmas is supposed to usher in? The angels declared, "Glory to God in the highest, & on earth peace..." But where is it? The world is still in complete turmoil!

Is peace simply an illusion? Is it just wishful thinking? Simply unattainable?

"Christmas isn't what brings peace... Christmas is a promise that Jesus will bring peace to all who believe!" "And when the time is right, we will all get to go home!" Some of those 9 million soldiers... got to experience that peace!

The gospel is not a message that peace is found in the absence of wars, quarrels, disagreements, hostility, & unrest... For these things will continue...

If they continued after this amazing Christmas truce in WWI... just as they continued after the amazing arrival of the Son of God into this world... they will continue today as well as we live in this same broken and fallen world!

But the gospel is a gospel of peace! Just of a different kind... Found elsewhere... The message of the heavenly host rings true, but not in the ways we may think!

Those WWI soldiers... Mary & Joseph... those Jewish families... they didn't experience the world's peace... but they did have a heavenly peace!

We are in a battle on 3 fronts... With one another... with ourselves... and even with God... There may be temporary ceasefires... but the war is not over!

True peace isn't the absence of external conflict or inner turmoil... Peace is a gift... A gift that keeps on giving... that enables us to <u>persevere</u> in faith, hope & love, even in the midst of the ongoing conflicts & turmoil experienced in this life

Jesus said "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid."

Peace comes from <u>outside ourselves</u>... it originates with God, and is extended to us through Jesus Christ! This is truly a different kind of peace!

The worlds peace is temporary... dependent upon us... and superficial! God's peace is eternal... truly a gift... and experienced in real tangible ways!
