

Heidelberg Catechism

Question 86.

We have been delivered from our misery by God's grace alone through Christ and not because we have earned it: why then must we still do good?

Answer.

To be sure, Christ has redeemed us by his blood.

But we do good because Christ by his Spirit is also renewing us to be like himself, so that in all our living we may show that we are thankful to God for all he has done for us,

and so that he may be praised through us.
