Belgic Confession Article 29 (excerpt)

The true church can be recognized if it has the following marks:

The church engages in the pure preaching of the gospel; it makes use of the pure administration of the sacraments as Christ instituted them;

it practices church discipline for correcting faults.

In short, it governs itself according to the pure Word of God, rejecting all things contrary to it and holding Jesus Christ as the only Head.

By these marks one can be assured of recognizing the true church-and no one ought to be separated from it.

From the Perkins Family:

We're doing well. Most of the news in the US is about Israel and Palestine, of course, with a bit of Iran sprinkled in, but we're impacted by all of that about as much as you all in Ohio. It's a topic of conversation among people, but that's about it. The one thing that could be more impactful is interaction with Iran. There have been a few moments when people have wondered whether a wider regional war would break out. We are thankful that peace has prevailed.

Our family is doing well overall. The kids are busy with school, Alison is busy teaching and interacting with her students, and I am continuing to be busy with our training program and working with international churches. I'm also now the lead facilitator for a network of organizations that focus their ministry on the Arabian Peninsula.

How can you pray for us?

- 1. Pray for this semester's workshop series on Culture and Worldview. People in our training program are learning more about religion, worldview, and how to lovingly talk about Jesus with their friends and neighbors who don't know Jesus.
- Pray for opportunities to invite people who don't know Jesus to read scripture with us. Pray that people would be responsive to those invitations.
- 3. Praise for good opportunities in the last few months to present to pastors of international churches about how to help their church reach into their communities with the Good News in loving and appropriate ways.
