SERMON – In God we T.R.U.S.T. What do we TREASURE? Matthew 6:19-24

What does it mean to trust in God? "That we acknowledge Him as the only true God, look to him for every good thing, humbly and patiently, love him, fear him, and honor him with all our heart. In short, that we give up anything rather than go against his will in any way." H.C. #94

What does this look like in our daily lives?

H.C. #95 – What is <u>idolatry?</u> Idolatry is having or inventing something in which one trusts in place of or alongside of the only true God, who has revealed himself in his Word.

What does it mean to trust in something *"in place of or alongside of the only true God*?"

It means to <u>treasure</u>/to put a high value on/to set our hearts on the things of this world that often compete for the rightful place of God in our lives? *"For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." – Matthew 6:21*

What is it that we treasure/give our hearts to/trust in that can never measure up to, or satisfy us, like God can?



Do you see anything wrong with this picture? It looks fine at first glance, doesn't it... until we look a little closer!

The 1st commandment says "You shall have no other <u>gods</u> before me." That doesn't just mean in order... but in the presence of/competing with!

And it doesn't just include golden calves, Asherah poles, and Greek mythological figures... It refers to anything/anyone that takes the place of God and His will, His purpose, His glory in our lives!

We break this commandment when we treasure <u>created things</u> at the expense of acknowledging, & responding to God, as our true & highest treasure... Romans 1:25 – "They worshipped & served created things rather than their creator!" This year's VBS theme "ARRRRR YOU SEEKING THE REAL TREASURE?" Listen to this definition of treasure... "Treasure is anything we seek/value above all else... and that which <u>motivates us to action!</u>"

What is the treasure we seek, the little "gods" that we turn to/create rather than turning to, trusting in, & treasuring above all else the one true God?



Maybe it's <u>"gold/money"</u> that we trust in & treasure...

How much does money have a hold on our hearts? How much is enough? What is the purpose of money? Whose money is it anyway?



Maybe it's <u>"goods/possessions</u> that we trust in &

treasure... How tempting is the accumulation of "stuff" for us? What's the source of our joy? Why do we often let our "stuff" define us?



Maybe it's our <u>"goals"</u> that we trust in & treasure... The

"American Way"... making something of ourselves... is our way of life... But what does it really mean to have lived the American dream? What is success?

Setting goals, and living a dream are not the problem... but what those goals are, and what dream you want to live, can be!



Maybe it's <u>"golf/sports/recreation"</u> that we trust in &

treasure... How much of our time, resources, passion (& that of our children) is consumed in sports & recreation? There is a difference between what we can enjoy for pleasure, & something that has become for us our treasure!

Have these things become idols for us? Do we treasure them above God? What are some honest questions we can ask ourselves to reveal the truth?

It is easy to say we trust in God... but actions speak louder than our words! Luke 16:19-31 – Are we seeking the good things/treasures of this world, or those of the world to come? Who do you trust... What will you treasure?
