SERMON – In God we T.R.U.S.T. – Reaping & Sowing!

Last Sunday I asked the question, "What do we treasure?" Today I am asking the question, "What are we <u>planting?</u>"

There is a principle in Scripture that says *"a man will reap what he sows..."* We can T.R.U.S.T. that this principle of REAPING & SOWING holds true... "R"

There are plenty of examples in <u>Scripture</u>... (King Saul, David, Samson, etc.) There are plenty of examples in <u>life</u>... (eating, working out, investing, etc.) We reap the consequences... rewards... outcomes... of what we <u>plant!</u>

It's Father's Day... one of my favorite verses in the Bible, as a father, is **Proverbs 22:6** - "Train up a child in the way he should go; even when he is old he will not depart from it."

This verse is a constant reminder of the importance of planting good seed in the lives of our children... as well as a constant warning of the <u>alternative!</u>

Today may be a real joy for some of us, because our fathers sowed good seed into our lives... or as a father, we have sowed good things into our children... But for others, today may be a constant reminder of <u>our sorrow</u>...

Though this Biblical principle of "reaping & sowing" is trustworthy, it is not the whole story... We are not the <u>only one's planting/sowing in the garden</u>...

What we reap is also a result of what those around us have/are sowing... Sometimes the joys, & the sorrows, in our lives have less to do with us and more to do with others, and what they are sowing!

Examples - Job... Samuel's sons... The prodigal son's father...Their suffering was not a result of their own failures, but the result of the <u>decisions of others</u>.

This should give us a better understanding, and a balance, in answering the questions... "Why is this happening?" "Why are things the way they are?"

But even this realization, of what others contribute to what we are reaping, is not the whole story... Sometimes what we reap is less about what we have sown, or what others have also sown, and more about what <u>God is sowing</u>...

Examples – Job... The man born blind... Jesus... Sometimes the only answer

for why certain things happen the way they do is because <u>God ordains it!</u>

We need a balanced approach of all 3 Biblical truths... if we are going to understand Scripture accurately & respond to it appropriately!

Placing our T.R.U.S.T. in God is trusting in His sovereignty & His good plan...

- Accepting that His ways are <u>higher</u> than our ways...
- Accepting that sin & brokenness in this world cause real pain/suffering...
- Acknowledging that what we do <u>matters</u> & that we do reap what we sow!

Galatians 6:7-10 - For whatever one sows, that will he also reap. For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life. And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up. ¹⁰ So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith.
