Faith in S.T.A.G.E.S. – Growing in Numbers (25-49yrs old)

Today we will be talking about another stage in our life and faith... But let's recap where we've been before we enter into this new stage!

"Starting Out" (0-12yrs old) – Connecting with Christ & the Church!

"Teens & Tweens" (13-17yrs old) - Discovering our identity amidst change!

"Adulting" (18-24yrs old) - Navigating thru seasons of wandering/disconnection

"Growing in Numbers" (25-49yrs old) - Experiencing additions in our lives!

In this 4th stage of life & faith things are increasing and at a rapid pace!

- We increase in age... At a pace we don't like to admit!
- We increase by +1... We get married!
- We increase by another +1, +2, +3... We have kids!
- We increase in responsibilities... We are now caring for a family!
- We increase from paying a couple bills to a whole stack every month!
- We increase from part-time jobs to full-time careers!
- We increase from minimum wage incomes to increased salary wages!
- We increase from needing to be in 1 place at 1 time to 3 places at once!
- We increase in stress... anxiety... weight... grey hair... hair loss... etc.

How do we have time for faith development & spiritual growth with everything else increasing in our lives exponentially? The same way we have time for anything else... We <u>prioritize it</u> & use our time more effectively!

In this stage of increase also comes increased opportunities to make decisions that will have life-long & eternal implications... not only in our own life but in the lives of all those who God brings into our sphere of <u>influence!</u>

Joshua 24:14-15 - "Now therefore fear the LORD & serve him in sincerity & in faithfulness. Put away the gods that your fathers served beyond the River & in Egypt, & serve the LORD. And if it is evil in your eyes to serve the LORD, choose this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your fathers served in the region beyond the River, or the gods of the Amorites in whose land you dwell. But as for me & my house, we will serve the LORD."

What does it mean to have a healthy "fear of the Lord"? Deut. 10:12-13

What does it mean to "serve him with sincerity & faithfulness"? Matt. 6:33

What does it mean to "put away other gods that your fathers served..."?

What does it mean to not see it as "evil in your eyes to serve the Lord"?
