Today we will be celebrating the Sacrament of Holy Communion. We invite all those who are baptized and have accepted Jesus Christ as their personal Savior and Lord to partake of this sacrament with us.

Heidelberg Catechism

Question 75. How does the Lord's Supper remind you and assure you that you share in Christ's one sacrifice on the cross and in all his gifts?

Answer. In this way: Christ has commanded me and all believers to eat of this broken bread and to drink this cup.

With this command he gave this promise:

First, as surely as I see with my eyes the bread of the Lord broken for me and the cup given to me, so surely his body was offered and broken for me and his blood was poured out for me on the cross.

Second, as surely as I receive from the hand of the one who serves, and taste with my mouth the bread and the cup of the Lord, given me as sure signs of Christ's body and blood, so surely he nourishes and refreshes my soul for everlasting life with his crucified body and poured out blood.
