Have you ever played the role of an intercessor?

Have you ever needed an intercessor between you and someone else?

The role of an intercessor is an important one... especially when stakes are high!

- When a husband & wife step into a pastor's office, divorce papers in hand, & say "We are on our way to turn these in but stopped here first!"
- When a teenage daughter comes to her parents and says, "I'm pregnant... and I want to keep the baby, but my boyfriend does not!"
- When a neighbor comes over and says, "I've been really struggling with thoughts of taking my own life... and for some reason I felt like I needed to tell someone... and here I am..."

What an <u>opportunity</u> for that pastor, for those parents, for that neighbor to intercede and save a marriage... a baby in the womb... a neighbor's life!

What would the outcome have been with that husband & wife, that teenage girl & her baby, that hurting neighbor if someone wasn't there to advocate for them at their exact time of need?

We can all probably recall situations in our lives when we played the role of intercessor, as well as when someone else interceded for us... but do we see the need, and the provision, of <u>Jesus Christ</u> as our chief intercessor?

No one else can intercede like He can/does in our greatest times of need!

What are these times of need? Where Jesus steps in & intercedes for us?

- In our battles with <u>ourselves</u>... We are our own worst enemy!

- In our battles with the devil... 1 Peter 5:8 He looks to devour someone!
