- *Stephanie Beck and Gail Bindel as deacons

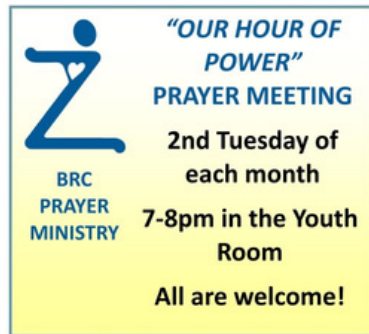
