Heidelberg Catechism

Question 29. Why is the Son of God called "Jesus," meaning Savior?

Answer. Because he saves us from our sins. Salvation cannot be found in anyone else; it is futile to look for any salvation elsewhere.

Question 30. Do those who look for their salvation and security in saints, in themselves, or elsewhere really believe in the only savior Jesus?

Answer. No. Although they boast of being his, by their deeds they deny the only savior and deliverer, Jesus. Either Jesus is not a perfect savior, or those who in true faith accept this savior have in him all they need for their salvation.
