

A new sermon series starts next Sunday. Last year we spent a lot of time looking at "WHAT" we believe with the Doctrinal Floor sermon series."

For the next 3 months we are going to just look at the life of Jesus, through the 4 gospel accounts and simply talk about how Jesus lived. This series will be called "The Jesus Way", and will answer the question "How did Jesus live, and how can we better follow in His footsteps?"



To help us answer that question, and in addition to being here on Sunday's we want to invite you to join us in a daily Bible reading plan through the gospels.

On the Daily Bible App there is a reading plan called "Before the Cross: The Life of Jesus". It is an 86 day (I only found one with 80 days?) reading plan that will take us to Palm Sunday at the end of March, and it will chronologically walk us through the life of Jesus. I want to really encourage you to go on this journey with us and discover more fully "The Jesus Way". There will be links and QR codes, as well as paper copies available very soon. Keep an eye on your email inbox for more information.
