*For families who send two or more sibling campers: each camper will receive a \$25 discount **to receive discount all registrations and payments must be registered online together**


If you don't have teenagers and you would like to help send a teen to camp please contact Pastor Dan about how you can contribute to this life-changing opportunity for our youth.

The Belgic Confession (excerpt)

Article 33: The Sacraments

We believe that our good God, mindful of our crudeness and weakness, has ordained sacraments for us to seal his promises in us, to pledge good will and grace toward us, and also to nourish and sustain our faith.

God has added these to the Word of the gospel to represent better to our external senses both what God enables us to understand by the Word and what he does inwardly in our hearts, confirming in us the salvation he imparts to us.

For they are visible signs and seals of something internal and invisible, by means of which God works in us through the power of the Holy Spirit.
