The Heidelberg Catechism

Question 86. Since we have been delivered from our misery by grace alone through Christ, without any merit of our own, why must we yet do good works?

Answer. 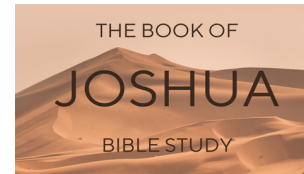
