### Open (Sharing our Own Stories & Getting To Know One Another)

1. What is the craziest stunt you have ever seen performed? 2. Why do people attempt these stunts? 3. Why do people enjoy watching these attempts?

### Going Deeper Into God's Word Together

Read aloud 2 Kings 22.14-23.4; Psalm 4; Acts 26.19-29.

Kings: 1. What will be the consequences for the people of Judah for angering God and turning away from him? What consequences do believers now bear when they turn from God? 2. How does God respond to King Josiah, and how does God respond now to believers who repent and turn toward him once again? 3. What actions does King Josiah take that help others return to God? What actions should present-day believers take to do the same?

Psalm: 1. What is causing David's distress? 2. How does David show compassion for others? 3. What brings David peace and joy? How can we apply this psalm to our own lives?

Acts: 1. What is Paul's mission? 2. Why do people today, like King Agrippa, fail 'to see the light' of God's truth and respond to it by turning to him? 3. What sustains and strengthens Paul in his situation that has application to today's Christians?
