1. What is the most magnificent building you've ever been in? 2. What is its purpose? Is it free to everyone? 3. How did you feel inside? Why?

### Going Deeper Into God's Word Together

**Read aloud 2 Chronicles 6.32-39, 7.1-3; Psalm 14.1-7; Romans 3.19-30**

Chronicles: 1. What groups of people might draw to God in prayer? (according to these verses) 2. What are their needs? How can Christians help meet those needs? 3. The Israelites knew God was present when fire came down from heaven. How do we feel God's presence in his church?

Psalm: 1. What is life like for those who turn away from God? 2. What hope is there for the righteous? 3. What witness can Christians give to those seeking God?

Romans: 1. In what ways can believing the truth of vs. 23 & 24 change a person's life? 2. How does one come to faith in Jesus Christ, in order to be redeemed by him? 3. What do we come to understand about God's qualities from these verses?
