Read aloud Jeremiah 16.19-21; Psalm 77.10-15; Colossians 3.18-4.6

Jeremiah: 1. What are the 'false gods' nations possess today? 2. How does God teach people about his power and might? Where do we see it or experience it? 3. Why would God want people to know about his power and might? What is the consequence(s) for those who refuse to learn?

Psalm: 1. What do Christians learn by remembering the deeds of the Lord? 2. What powers did God display among his peoples that we remember? 3. What does it mean for Christians that God redeems his people?

Colossians: 1. How are all of our earthly relationships impacted if we love Christ? 2. Why does Paul urge Christians to be prayerful, watchful, and thankful? 3. How would it change our days if we consciously lived serving Christ, not men?
