Dear Parents.

We have been studying multiplication for the past few weeks to understand how multiplication works. We are now transitioning into memorizing our facts. We will be taking a timed test each day to practice fluency. We will be having a class ice cream party to celebrate our fact fluency. As your student passes each time test, they will earn a different topping for their ice cream sundae! The date of our ice cream sunday party will be **Friday**, **December 14th**. That means your child has 4 weeks to pass the 10 multiplication timed tests. Accommodations will be made as needed to help each child be successful.

You can help your child by practicing their multiplication facts with them at home. A third grader should be able to recall multiplication facts with automaticity, meaning they don't have to stop and count to solve the problem. Practicing with you child is the best thing you can do to help them become fluent.
