- ➔ Dismissal: 3:23 p.m.



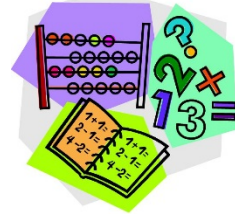


A day in 2nd grade:

Spanish

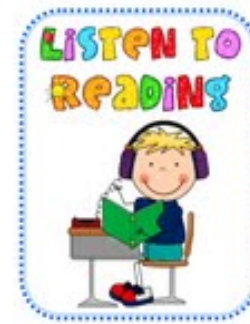
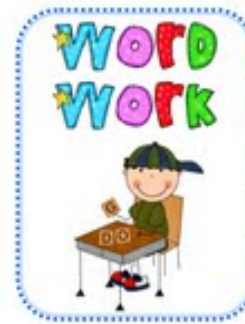
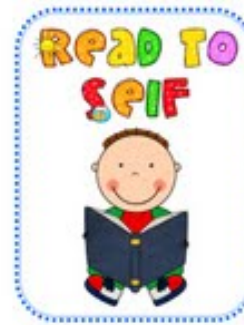
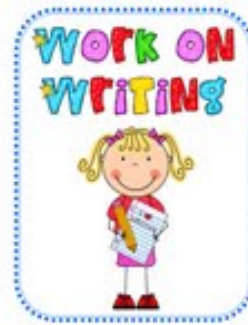


- ➔ Goals: To be able to communicate in Spanish, learning vocabulary and using it correctly, summarizing stories by speaking or writing, ...
