Who are we looking for to lead us for the present:

We are seeking an experienced minister to serve as our bridge pastor. We prefer the candidate to have Full Standing in the UCC or be from a partner denomination consistent with the theological orientation of the UCC.

- Lead congregational Worship each week on a virtual platform, currently using zoom with Tech Deacon support.
- Work and meet with the Worship and Music Ministry Team which includes the Music Coordinator, in planning
- Coordinate worship among the staff, tech, liturgist, musicians, and volunteers.
- Attend the Church Council meetings (3rd Wed of each month and 1st Wed as needed).

Who we are:

Alki UCC is a small but strong and compassionate congregation, about 70 members. We are open and affirming, progressive congregation who care about the community and is actively involved in social justice outreach. We were blessed to have a transitional pastor for the last 18 months who led us in our organizational restructuring and staff development, as well as working with Hope Ministries in writing our Future Story. We are now in the process of implementing that story and will be seeking a designated or settled pastor in the near future who will work with us to develop our vision of an Multifaith Community Center.
