Honor your father and your mother,

You shall not murder.

You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.

You shall not covet your neighbor's house;

you shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or male or female slave, or ox, or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.

When all the people witnessed the thunder and lightning,

the sound of the trumpet, and the mountain smoking,

they were afraid and trembled and stood at a distance,

and said to Moses, "You speak to us, and we will listen;

but do not let God speak to us, or we will die."
